

WHY DOES FRANKLING HIGH SCHHOL HAVE A BOOSTER CLUB?

The Booster Club is necessary. It is a volunteer organization that provides the major requirements as the umbrella for fund raising events and support to the sports groups or clubs at Franklin High School.

What is that umbrella?

1. The Booster Club is an established Non-Profit organization under the Federal Government as a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) and contributions to the corporation which are tax deductible under Section 170(c)(2) requirements of the Internal Revenue Code.
2. The Booster Club is a California Non-Profit Corporation. This means the term of "Liability" is on the Corporation, not officers or registered members for any law suits.
3. The Booster Club has the approval of the FHS Administration and the EGUSD Board of Trustees to operate as the auxiliary unit to Franklin High School as prescribed by California Education Code §72670 by the Board Resolution Number 22, 2002-03.
4. The Booster Club provides liability insurance and major insurance to cover special events at other venues not at Franklin High School.
5. The Booster Club provides a centralized bank account and bookkeeping system to manage each account for the sports groups and clubs at Franklin High School.
6. The Booster Club provides a Bond insurance that covers the liability for those that handle money.
7. The Booster Club provides a centralized management team: The Corporate Board of Directors who are responsible for the overall management of Booster affairs at Franklin High School.
 - a. This is written in the By-Laws of the Corporation, and
 - b. Policies and Procedures, and
 - c. A pamphlet about "Who is the Booster Club".
8. The Booster Club files annual Tax Reports to the Federal and State Governments.
9. The Booster Club meets once each month to:
 - a. Help communicate about a booster activities at Franklin High School,
 - b. Provide status reports of the booster treasury,
 - c. Learn about booster auxiliary group's activities and fund raising events, and
 - d. Plan major fund raising events at the Booster Club Level of support in cooperation with all sports groups and clubs at Franklin High School.
10. The "FHS Booster Club" was organized as the support group for Franklin High School that could stand alone as a functioning organization to support Franklin High School and its activities with funds raised to support and benefit Franklin High School and students.
